

Frequently Asked Questions about studying your Macquarie degree in the City!

(Q) Is my degree from the city campus the same as at North Ryde?

(A) Yes. Students graduating from the city campus are Macquarie University graduates. **The degree certificate and transcripts are exactly the same in the city as at North Ryde.** In addition, the academic staff are all approved by Macquarie University and many work on both campuses. All academic staff are highly qualified with many having studied a PhD or double Master's degree. If you would like to see an example of the degree certificate and transcripts, please ask the reception at SIBT or look on the wall at reception for an example.

(Q) What undergraduate courses are available at the city campus?

(A) Bachelor of Arts (Media, Culture and Communication)
Bachelor of Arts (major in Cultural Studies)
Bachelor of Commerce – Professional Accounting
Bachelor of Business Administration

(Q) Can I start at the city campus in November?

(A) Yes. The city campus has 3 intakes per year. You have the opportunity to fast-track your degree in the city.

(Q) What GPA do I need to enter the city campus?

(A) The entry requirements for the city campus are the same as North Ryde. For a complete list of entry requirements, please check our website.

(Q) Can I get relevant work experience in the city?

(A) Yes. The city campus offers temporary internships for students wishing to gain unpaid workplace experience within a business environment. Internships provide on-the-job training, practical work experience and increase your potential to obtain work in your field of study.

(Q) Can I still use the facilities at North Ryde if I study in the city campus?

(A) Yes. City campus students have access to the services and facilities located on the North Ryde campus including the sporting facilities, clubs and societies, health services and the library. The students can utilize the inter-library loan service and library facilities at other Australian Universities. The city campus also has its own library, computer rooms and wireless internet access and state-of-the-art classroom facilities.
