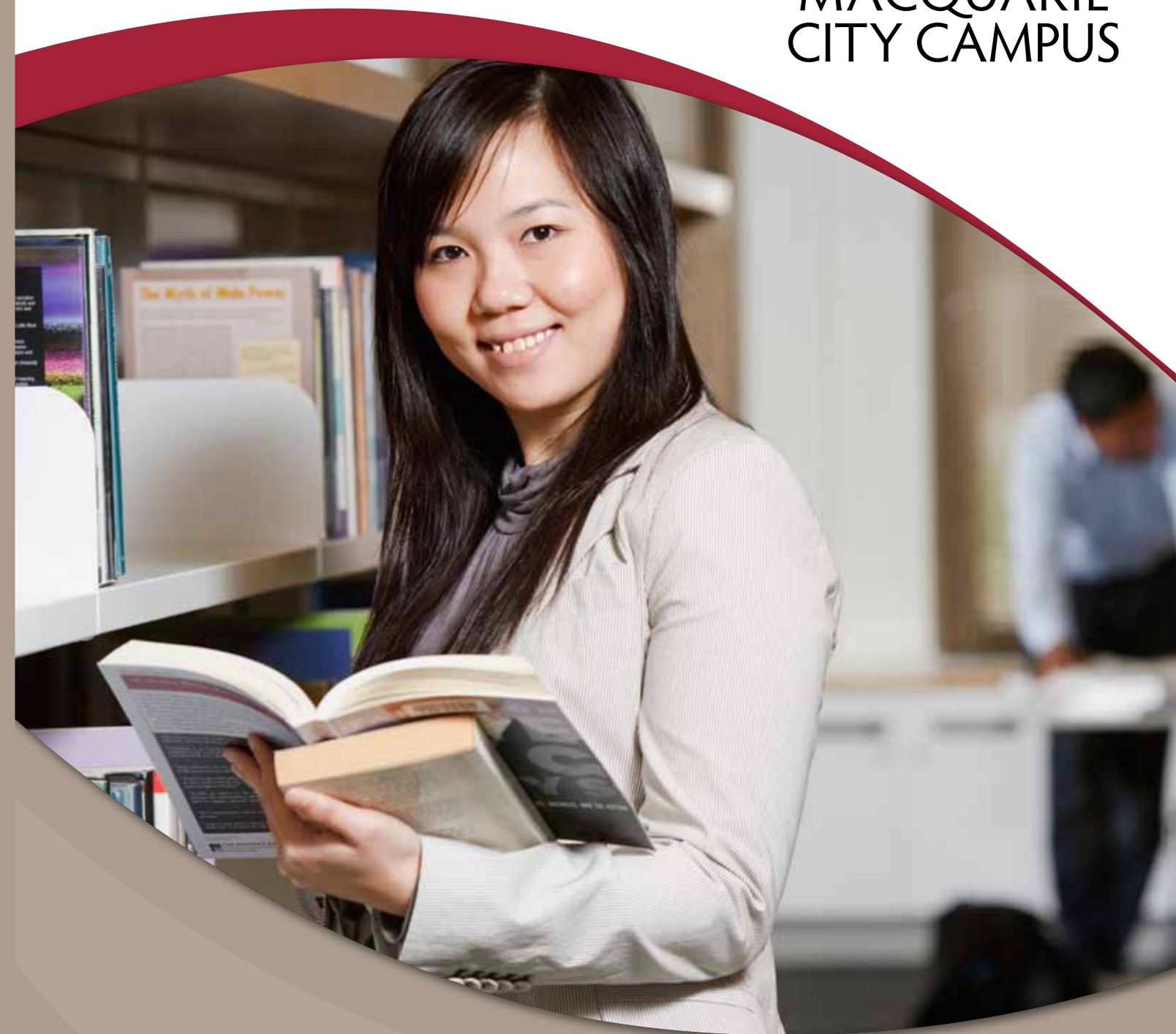

Obtain the qualifications that you need by studying Postgraduate Accounting at Macquarie City Campus

Macquarie's postgraduate accounting courses provide a path for university graduates in any discipline to acquire accounting qualifications that are fully recognised by CPA Australia and The Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia (ICAA).

Course Features

Qualify from a non-accounting Bachelor degree

Students who hold a Bachelor degree in any discipline have the opportunity to earn a widely recognised and respected postgraduate academic qualification.

Preparation for CPA and CA professional programs

Units have been designed to meet the educational requirements of CPA Australia, ICAA and other international accounting bodies. The programs provide thorough preparation for the CPA or CA programs and are taught by highly qualified teaching staff many of whom have had first-hand experience with the CPA and CA programs.

Graduates achieve the best grades

Macquarie graduates consistently rank higher in grade results in the CPA program than non-Macquarie graduates and demonstrate the significant benefits of completing the professional program through Macquarie. There is a particular focus on communicative competence as well as strong technical skills.

Suitable for students who work full-time

Classes are held in the evening and at weekends. Local students can study full-time or part-time however international students must enrol in a full-time study load each study period.

Eligibility

- Bachelor degree in any discipline from a recognised university with a GPA of 2.7 (out of 4.00).
- Students whose first degree was not taught in English are required to demonstrate proficiency in English (IELTS of 6.5 overall with 6.0 in each section, TOEFL of 580 with 50 in each section).
- Work experience is not required for admission.
- Applicants for the Master of Accounting (CPA Extension) who hold a degree from an overseas university must have their qualification assessed by CPA Australia. Please contact CPA Australia for details of the assessment procedure (www.cpaaustralia.com.au).

Exemption Policy

A maximum of 5 exemptions can be granted for equivalent units completed at an Australian university, no more than 3 years prior to enrolment.

Single Unit Availability

Members of graduate entry overseas accounting bodies who require only Taxation Law and Company Law for admission to CPA or The ICAA can apply for these two units only.

2010 COURSES

There are two postgraduate accounting programs to choose from.

1. Master of Accounting (Professional) CRICOS CODE 068956G

For: University graduates of any discipline who wish to obtain a qualification that is fully recognised by CPA Australia and ICAA.

Structure: Completion of 13 units over 3 semesters, and one summer session (ACCG854 or ACCG857).

The structure above represents a full-time study load. International students must enrol full-time. Domestic students may study part-time.

2. Master of Accounting (CPA Extension) CRICOS CODE 022767D

For: International students who wish to reside in Australia while gaining a professional accounting qualification in Australia by completing the CPA program, or domestic students who require extensive support for the CPA program.

Structure: 13 units of the Master of Accounting (Professional) and the CPA Extension component. The Master degree includes completion of the CPA Australia program and Macquarie's CPA support units (4 core and 2 elective).
