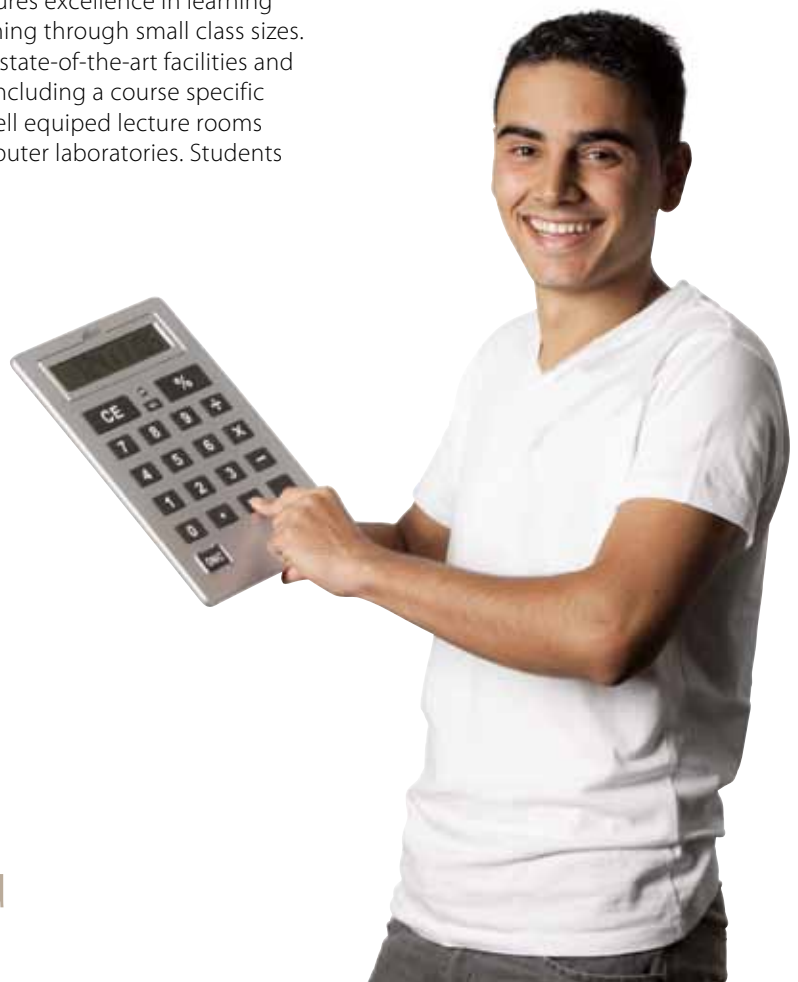

School leavers

Students with a keen interest in mathematics and a strong ATAR or equivalent, have the opportunity to earn a widely recognised and respected Macquarie University degree.

Preparation for CPA and CA professional programs

Units in the Bachelor of Commerce-Professional Accounting meet the educational requirements of CPA Australia, ICAA and other international accounting bodies. The program provides thorough preparation for the CPA and CA programs and is taught by highly-qualified teaching staff many of whom have had first-hand experience of the CPA and CA programs.

Career Opportunities

This course provides an excellent foundation for a range of accounting-based careers. Graduates gain employment as strategic business advisers, management consultants, accountants (in the 'Big four' accountancy firms and elsewhere), stockbrokers, taxation consultants, finance analysts, finance advisers, auditors, investment managers, bankers and futures traders.

Suitable for students who work full-time

Most classes are held during the day between 8.00am – 5.00pm, though some classes are held between 6.00pm – 9.00pm. Local students can study full-time or part-time however international students must enrol in a full-time study load each study period.

Eligibility

This course is suitable for students with a strong ATAR (in 2009 the UAI was 83.10) who wish to fulfill tertiary educational requirements for entry into the CPA program or the ICAA program. Students will develop the ability to think strategically and work independently, whilst improving their business, leadership and communication skills.
